NOTE: BC means Basecoat; **DB** means Dry Brush; **HL** means High Light; **WB** means Wipe Back using #763 Antique Media; **PB** means Pat Back with soft cloth. **Spray** means spray with a Matt Spray.
NOTE: Always refer to picture for placement of colors.

Roll a single coat of glaze on the inside and fire according the directions given on the jar. This will make your item "Food Safe". If you do not have a kiln available for firing the glaze, you can order your bisque glazed on the inside.

Apply 2-3 smooth even coats of the following:

940 Toffee to all flesh; 900 White to beard, eyebrows, hair, hat fur, sheets and dust ruffle; and 910 Scarlet to hat

Blush lips, cheeks, finger nails & (lightly) top of head with #913 Blush mixed with #940 Toffee. Paint eyelashes and dashes on hat with 902 Black.

Paint designs on patches using the following:

900 White; 902 Black; 910 Scarlet; 912 Wine; 919 Clover Green; 925 Medium Blue; 928 Sweet Violet and any other colors you wish.

Paint trim on dust ruffle #910 Scarlet. Antique entire piece #1001 Bark. WB to HL.

Spray. Paint inside of box and lid #971 Gold. DB to of head with Glossy Sealer
