

## ab0473 Giant Pumpkin

NOTE: **BC** means Basecoat; **DB** means Dry Brush; **HL** means High Light; **WB** means Wipe Back using #763 Antique Media; **PB** means Pat Back with soft cloth. **Spray** means spray with a sealant. **NOTE: Always refer to picture for placement of colors.**

Begin by mixing equal parts k910 Scarlet Red and os435 Dark Yellow. **BC** entire piece with this mixture.

To the above mixture add a small amount of k918 Forest Green and dilute into a wash. Use this on the furrows around the stem on the lid.

Note: This next part can get a little messy. Be sure to use a drop cloth or newsprint to protect your work area.

Turn the bottom of the pumpkin upside down and apply this wash to the base allowing it to drip down the furrows. If desired apply some of this to create an “unripe spot” as shown in the image on the upper right.

**BC** all orange areas with a mixture of k917 Pumpkin and k910 Scarlet Red. Load a small amount of k919 Clover Green onto the brush for green/unripe areas and make sure to blend edges well.

Brush down with k804 Brown Pickling all over and wipe back. Dry thoroughly.

**DB** with k916 Sunset Orange, then k917 Pumpkin. Mix a bit of os435 Dark Yellow with k917 Pumpkin and **DB** green/unripe areas.

**BC** stem with an equal mixture of k905 Rich Brown and k954 Medium Brown. **DB** with k954 Medium Brown, then with k940 Toffee, and finally a mixture of k940 Toffee and k930 Sun Ray to highlight

Dry thoroughly and apply Matte Sealer all over.

k940 - Toffee

k954 – Medium Brown
