NOTE: BC means Basecoat; DB means Dry Brush; HL means High Light; WB means Wipe Back using #763 Antique Media; PB means Pat Back with soft cloth. Spray means spray with a Matt Spray. **NOTE: Always refer to picture for placement of colors.**

Roll a single coat of glaze on the inside and fire according the directions given on the jar. This will make your item "Food Safe". If you do not have a kiln available for firing the glaze, you can order your bisque glazed on the inside.

BC #750 Bisque Primer. Paint hooves, spots, tail & crown #902 Black. Paint muzzle and udders #914 Dusty Rose. Working with small area at a time, antique the entire piece #701 Black wiping back with Antique Media. DB #900 White if desired.

Spray. Paint the following: bow #928 Sweet Violet, collar #709 Topaz (WB to HL), leaves #918 Forest Green, eyes #900 White, iris #905 Rich Brown, pupils #902 Black & HL #900 White.

HL bow #900 White mixed with #928 Sweet Violet in brush. DB grass #900 White mixed with #918 Forest Green. Apply #711 Sapphire, #712 Amethyst & #713 Primrose on flowers and PB to HL. Paint centers #900 White. DB #710 Sunshine on grass to HL.

DB collar #905 Rich Brown and then mix #900 White in dirty brush and DB to HL.

Spray. Paint Brush-On Glossy Sealer on eyes. DB Brush-On Glossy Sealer over bow and collar. Paint bell #972 Silver.
