

## ce3001 – Candy Cane Bear

NOTE: BC means Basecoat; DB means Dry Brush; HL means High Light; WB means Wipe Back using #763 Antique Media; PB means Pat Back with soft cloth. Spray means spray with a Matt Spray. **NOTE: Always refer to picture for placement of colors.**

Mix #802 Blue Pickling and #a600 White Wash (1:1) and apply to bisque. DB #900 White over bear fur and candy cane. Paint the stripes on the candy cane #952 Crimson. When dry, DB #960 Summer Splash over Crimson stripes. Paint cape, hood & ribbon #946 Whisper Blue. When this is dry, load a ½" shaded with #923 Intense Blue and #946 Whisper Blue mixed and float color all around the edge of the cape, hood & ribbon. Paint eyes #900 White, iris #923 Intense Blue and pupils #902 Black. Paint eyelashes and lash lines #902 Black. HL #900 White.

DB holly leaves #919 Clover Green; berries #910 Scarlet Red and HL with #900 White. Paint nose #954 Medium Brown. DB #914 Dusty Rose over pads, inside ears, cheeks and mouth. Then using the same brush DB same areas with #960 Summer Splash to HL.



Spray. Apply Glossy Sealer to eyes.
