

## DH1195 – Dragon Stein

NOTE: BC means Basecoat; DB means Dry Brush; HL means High Light; WB means Wipe Back using #763 Antique Media; PB means Pat Back with soft cloth. Spray means spray with Matte Spray.

**NOTE: Always refer to picture for placement of colors.**

If you are going to glaze the stein and apply Fired Gold to the bands, you will want to do that first. Thin clear glaze (or a color of your choice) and roll inside the stein & lid. Drain any excess and be sure to wipe any drips or splatters from the outside of the stein. Very carefully apply clear glaze to the bands and fire according to directions on jar. Apply Fired Gold and fire according to directions on jar. Apply a masking agent to gold areas while painting.

BC with #750 Bisque Primer. Antique design area with #740 Walnut and WB to HL. Wipe blue area back to white. Apply #711 Sapphire to blue areas and WB to blend and lighten. Window behind Wizard is #711 Sapphire and lighten with #700 White.

Brick areas: Apply LIGHTLY #701 Black and WB to HL and lighten (leave black heavier in grout areas to shadow).

Wizard: Cape - Apply #713 Primrose. WB to HL; flesh areas - #909 Gentle Flesh, eyes #900 White, irises & pupils #902 Black & HL with #900 White; hair - apply #701 Black and WB then DB #900 White.

Gazing Ball: Mix #972 Silver with #700 White and paint ball. Claw bowl (ball is sitting in): #711 Sapphire & WB to HL. Claw hand: #703 Spiced Brown, WB with q-tip to HL. Talons are #902 Black.

Potion Bottles on table: #706 Tangerine and WB to HL. Flick #900 White here and there. Stoppers are painted #902 Black.

Book on table: DB #900 White with squiggles in #902 Black.

Books on shelf behind wizard's hand: #705 Ruby, #707 Evergreen, #703 Spiced Brown & #717 Mushroom. Potion bottle is #714 Teal and WB to HL. Flick on #900 White in a horizontal motions. Cap & pump are painted #700 White.

Knight: Plumb is heavily DB #900 White; Knight's clothing is #740 Walnut & #701 Black mixed in brush. WB to HL. Cape is #713 Primrose and WB to HL.

Horse is #703 Spiced Brown; nose is DB #701 Black and HL with #700 White. Horse's teeth are #700 White & tongue is #705 Ruby; mane & tail is heavily DB #700 White. Hoof is #902 Black. Paint eye #902 Black & HL #900 White.

All Dragons: #714 Teal & WB to HL. #701 Black on mouth and claws; teeth #900 White; eyes #910 Scarlet Red, HL with a dot of #900 White; horns #900 White; mane HL with #900 White. Talons in #902 Black.

Lid: BC #750 Bisque Primer and antique #740 Walnut. WB to HL. DB #707 Evergreen on grass areas. Add a touch of #701 Black on rocks and WB to HL. Paint #705 Ruby on castle brick and WB to HL. Dot windows #902 Black.

Spray. Paint: Glazing Ball, talons, all eyes, noses, horse's hoof with Glossy Sealer. Trim the potion bottles with #971 Gold & #972 Silver. Bowl on table next to small dragon is #971 Gold. Wizard's sleeves are detailed with #972 Silver. Knight helmet is #971 Gold & #972 Silver. Shoulder pads, elbow shield & wrist wrap, sword & hand guard are #971 Gold & #972 Silver. Javelin is #972 Silver. Horse's bridle, chest piece are outlined in #971 Gold; knee pads are #971 Gold & #972 Silver. Saddle tacks are dotted in #972 Silver. Dragon's tongue #973 New Penny. Castle: Paint roof #971 Gold. Paint torrents tops, arch around door and DB steps #972 Silver. Bands around stein and lid are #971 Gold. Paint belly scales #971 Gold, if desired.
