NOTE: BC means Basecoat; DB means Dry Brush; HL means High Light; WB means Wipe Back using #763 Antique Media; PB means Pat Back with soft cloth. Spray means spray with Matte Spray.

NOTE: Always refer to picture for placement of colors.

BC #750 Bisque Primer. Antique with #740 Walnut & #701 Black mixed in brush & WB to blend and HL. Use a moist, towel to take head, tail & feather tip back to white.

DB on #740 Walnut & #701 Black to eagle body, legs, wings & shadow tail feathers avoiding tips. Apply #709 Topaz & #706 Tangerine to feet & beak. HL #710 Sunshine, & PB. Shadow beak & head #701 Black. Paint eyes #902 Black & iris #907 Caramel & pupils #902 Black.

Apply #740 Walnut to rock area & WB. Apply #711 Sapphire & #712 Amethyst to rocks and blend using #763 Antique Media. DB LIGHTLT #936 Raspberry Sherbet on rocks (see picture for placement) WB to HL.

DB #900 White on head, tail feathers and under top row of feathers (see picture for placement).

Spray. DB Glossy Sealer to rocks. Paint Glossy Sealer on eyes, beak and talons.
