

DH1699 – Spring Dragon



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NOTE: BC means Basecoat; DB means Dry Brush; HL means High Light; WB means Wipe Back using #763 Antique Media; PB means Pat Back with soft cloth. Spray means spray with Matte Spray.

NOTE: Always refer to picture for placement of colors.

If you are going to apply Fired Gold, you will want to do that first. Very carefully apply clear glaze to gold areas and fire according to directions on jar. Apply Fired Gold and fire according to directions on jar. Apply a masking agent to gold areas while painting.

BC #750 Bisque Primer. Antique with #740 Walnut & #701 Black mixed in brush. WB to HL. WB eggs and rocks to white using #763 Antique Media as needed.

Referring to picture for placement. Apply the following colors to the dragons: #713 Primrose, #711 Sapphire, #712 Amethyst. WB to HL and shadow with #701 as needed. Apply #740 Walnut mixed with #703 Spiced Brown to tree stump. WB to HL with #704 Taupe. Apply #707 Evergreen to moss and WB to HL. Apply #711 Sapphire mixed with #700 White to eggs and WB to HL. Paint cracked area #700 White and PB. Shadow rocks with #701 Black and randomly apply LIGHTLY #713 Primrose, #711 Sapphire & #712 Amethyst. WB to Lighten and HL.

Paint eye #900 White, iris #923 Intense Blue & pupil's #902 Black. HL with #900 White.

Spray. DB #900 White on egg area to give a "cloudy" look. Apply Glossy Sealer to eggs & eyes.

Referring to picture: Paint #971 Gold on wing tips, eyes, nose and down back knobs if Fired Gold was NOT used.
