NOTE: BC means Basecoat; DB means Dry Brush; HL means High Light; WB means Wipe Back using #763 Antique Media; PB means Pat Back with soft cloth. Spray means spray with Matte Spray.
NOTE: Always refer to picture for placement of colors.

BC #750 Bisque Primer. Antique #740 Walnut and WB to HL. Take background, rocks and fish tail back as far as possible. Apply #711 Sapphire to background and WB to HL. Add #700 White to lighten if needed/desired.

Apply #703 Spiced Brown to log and PB. Apply #707 Evergreen to reeds. WB to HL. Using same brush apply #708 Emerald, the #710 Sunshine to HL. Apply #705 Ruby to flowers and WB to HL. Apply #717 Mushroom to rocks and PB.

Fish: apply #708 Emerald to top and WB. Apply #710 Sunshine to tail and under belly. Apply #705 Ruby to tongue and inside mouth, behind gills and behind body fin. (see picture for placement). WB to HL.

Spray. DB Glossy Sealer over plate for a "Wet" Look. Paint eyes and tongue Glossy Sealer. DB #974 Brush on Sparkle on fish body.
